2020 CRDA 25th Anniversary Scholarship Guidelines

Special note about volunteering: *Because of the unusual circumstances imposed by the state stay-at-home order, volunteer hour requirements for the scholarship are waived for 2020.*

- The \$500 scholarship is intended for educational purposes only. For example: clinics (mounted or unmounted), seminars, the “L” program, specific completion goals, etc.
- Applicants must be a CRDA member in good standing. (Applicants can send in a membership form and member dues along with their application.)
- Applicants must complete all required sections of the Scholarship Application form.
- Applicants must answer questions about their goals and experience.
- Completed applications with questions must be received by 10/1/2020.

- The winner will be selected solely at the discretion of the CRDA Board. Chief factors in deciding the winner will include (but are not limited to): the answers themselves, along with the educational benefits expressed, sportsmanship, and prior volunteering activities.
- CRDA officers and board members are excluded from applying for the Scholarship.
- Scholarship winners will not be eligible to receive a repeat scholarship two years in a row. Winners will be eligible to apply in subsequent years only if they have moved up at least one level, unless they are already competing at the FEI levels.
- The winner will be announced and presented with a scholarship check at the Year End Banquet on 11/21/2020. If the winner is not present, the award will be mailed to them.
