IMPORTANT SHOW INFORMATION:

- ◆ CRDA Schooling Shows are run in accordance with USEF Rules. Proper show attire is expected.
- ◆ **Horse number must be worn at all times; this includes while being lead with a halter/lead.**
- ◆ **For 2022, ALL entries must be complete prior to date of show in order to compete!**
- ◆ **All riders must wear properly fastened ASTM approved protective headgear at all times while mounted.**
- ◆ All competitors and riders must sign the Apple Knoll Farm Release & Indemnity Agreement once per year and return it to the Show Secretary. This form can be obtained on the CRDA website (www.crdressage.org) or the horseshow office at Apple Knoll Farm. If using Horse Show Office to submit an entry forms can be scanned with the entry, or emailed to the show secretary.
- ◆ All divisions will be ridden together in the same class however each division (Junior, Adult Amateur and Open) will be pinned separately - 1st through 6th place ribbon in each class.
- ◆ Each division is awarded a High Percentage Champion and Reserve Champion at each show. Scores will be included from classes 1-15.
- ◆ Riders are eligible as Juniors from the beginning of the calendar year until the end of the calendar year in which they reach the age of 18.
- ◆ Any person (Junior or Senior) who gives riding instruction, and/or receives compensation for riding or training, is considered a professional and, as such, is **ONLY** eligible for Open divisions. **NO EXCEPTIONS!**
- ◆ Please check the CRDA website (www.crdressage.org) for Leadline and Above Leadline Tests.
- ◆ The show management reserves the right to vary or change show officials or judges, to decline any entry, and cancel, divide or combine classes.
- ◆ For any class noted as TOC, you must specify the Level and Test number. (e.g. 3rd Level Test 3).
- ◆ Exhibitors are encouraged to leave their dogs at home. Any dog brought to the show grounds must remain leashed at all times.
- ◆ Show ride times will be posted on our website, www.crdressage.org no later than the Monday prior to the show.
- ◆ No refunds after closing date.
- ◆ Judges are TBD. Please check the CRDA website (www.crdressage.org) for names of judges.
- ◆ STALLS will not be available, except for show volunteers

Year-End Awards Criteria

CRDA has a great year-end awards program for competitors. Awards are given for the following divisions for a horse and rider combination:

Intro Level (any test):	Average of 3 highest scores at a minimum of 2 shows by 2 different judges (JR, AA, OPEN)
Training Level (any test):	Average of 3 highest scores at a minimum of 2 shows by 2 different judges (JR, AA, OPEN)
First Level (any test):	Average of 3 highest scores at a minimum of 2 shows by 2 different judges (JR, AA, OPEN)
Second Level and Above:	Average of 3 highest scores at a minimum of 2 shows by 2 different judges (JR, AA, OPEN)
Musical Freestyle:	Average of 2 highest scores at a minimum of 2 shows by 2 different judges (JR, AA, OPEN)
Leadline:	Average of 2 highest scores at a minimum of 2 shows by 2 different judges (JR ONLY)
Above Leadline:	Average of 2 highest scores at a minimum of 2 shows by 2 different judges (JR ONLY)
USEA TOC:	Average of 3 highest scores at a minimum of 2 shows by 2 different judges (JR, AA, OPEN)
Riders w/Disabilities:	Average of 3 highest scores at a minimum of 2 shows by 2 different judges (JR, AA, OPEN)
Prix Caprilli:	Average of 2 highest scores at a minimum of 2 shows by 2 different judges (JR, AA, OPEN)
Vintage:	50 to 59 Years of age (see details below) – Average of <u>all scores</u> , minimum of 3 scores by 2 different judges. (all divisions rated together).
Master:	60+ Years of age (see details below) – Average of <u>all scores</u> , minimum of 3 scores by 2 different judges. (all divisions rated together).

CRDA also has the following **Rider High Point awards:**

Overall High Point: Average of all scores received at a minimum of 3 tests, at 2 shows by 2 different judges (**JR, AA, OPEN**). (**Can be ridden on multiple horses**)

Competitors must meet the following criteria to receive a year-end award:

- In each level, rider's eligible scores are taken from any of the tests available at that level.
- Rider must be a member of CRDA in good standing (dues paid prior to the show date) for scores to count.
- Must have contributed at least 4 hours of volunteer time to CRDA during the year. Show volunteer's hours are tracked by the Volunteer Coordinator. For volunteer time at other events, please make sure to return a signed volunteer form to the Volunteer Coordinator by September 30, 2022.
- Volunteer hours **MUST** be completed by the member themselves, unless they are less than 10 years of age or under. Children under 10 years of age can have a friend or family member donate hours. This must be communicated up front prior to the start of the volunteer hours.
- All volunteer hours **MUST** be completed by 09/30/2022.
- Leadline, Above Leadline, Prix Caprilli, and Musical Freestyle scores are not eligible for Overall Rider High Point award calculations.
- Ribbons to be awarded to Champion through 6th place (if entries warrant).
- Awards and other honors will be presented at the Annual Banquet.
- Awards will be divided into Open, Junior, and Adult Amateur.
- Riders are eligible as Juniors from the beginning of the calendar year until the end of the calendar year in which they reach the age of 18.
- Riders are eligible for the Vintage Year End Award starting January 1st when the rider is 50 years old.
- Riders are eligible for the Masters (and no longer the Vintage) Year End Award starting January 1st when the rider is 60 years old.
