Eligibility Requirements:

- Applicants must complete 4 hours of volunteer service for CRDA by the time the application is submitted. These hours will count toward both Scholarship and Year-End Award Eligibility.
- Applicants must be a CRDA member in good standing.

Scholarship Details:

- The scholarship amount is \$500.
- Junior applicants may also apply for the \$500 Sage Farm Scholarship but may only receive one of these scholarships.
- The scholarship is designated for educational purposes only. This includes participation in clinics (mounted or unmounted), seminars, specific competition goals, and related travel expenses.

Please ensure that all application materials, including proof of volunteer hours, are submitted by the deadline.
