

CRDA Virtual Horse Show Regulations

Updated August 3, 2020

Article I. Rider Attire

Section 1.01 Clinic attire required

- (a) Show attire optional

Section 1.02 Helmets required

Article II. Equipment

Section 2.01 All equipment must comply with USDF guidelines

- (a) Examples:

- (i) Ear bonnets allowed*
- (ii) Boots and wraps not allowed*

Article III. Ring Requirements

Section 3.01 Must have eight letters for Intro, Training, and Eventing TOC

Section 3.02 Must have twelve letters for First level and up

- (a) It is acceptable for letters to be handwritten on paper and taped to wall/fence
- (b) Letters must be large enough to be visible on video

Section 3.03 Any size ring acceptable

Article IV. Video Requirements

Section 4.01 Editing and/or stopping the video is not allowed

- (a) You may not edit together clips from different videos

Section 4.02 You may film your test(s) as many times as you would like, but again, you may not edit pieces of different videos together

- (a) So, don't worry if you go off course! You can try again

Section 4.03 Please film with your phone or camera horizontally, in landscape orientation

Section 4.04 At the beginning of the video announce the following information:

- (a) Your name, your horse's name, and the test you are riding
 - (i) Ensure that it is audible on the recordings*

- (b) Make a lap around the arena before riding down the centerline

Section 4.05 Audio must be on and able to be heard in the recording

- (a) Coaching is not allowed
- (b) Earbuds are not allowed
- (c) Music is not allowed unless submitting a Freestyle
- (d) Test reader is allowed

Section 4.06 Zooming in is allowed, but not required

Section 4.07 You cannot use the same video for more than one show

Section 4.08 Videographer must stand at C

- (a) Cellphone videos are completely acceptable
- (b) Hiring a professional is discouraged, but not forbidden

Article V. General

Section 5.01 Each class will be pinned to sixth place in Junior, Adult Amateur, and Open divisions

- (a) Results will be posted on the CRDA website within 10 days of the video submissions closing date
- (b) Ribbons and test sheets will be mailed to participants

Section 5.02 High point awards will be distributed for the virtual horse show series (July, August, & September) in Junior, Adult Amateur, and Open divisions

- (a) Only participants who are current members of CRDA are eligible for high point awards
- (b) Only participants who comply with all the rules will be eligible for high point awards
- (c) Awards will be determined by the average of the three highest scores from at least two shows per horse and rider combination
 - (i) *The scores do not need to be from the same level*

Section 5.03 Champion and Reserve Champion awards will be distributed at each level for the virtual horse show series (July, August, & September)

- (a) These awards will not be per division. There will only be one Champion and Reserve Champion per level regardless of the winners' divisions
- (b) Only participants who are current members of CRDA are eligible for these awards
- (c) Only participants who comply with all the rules will be eligible
- (d) Awards will be determined by the average of the three highest scores from at least two shows per level and per horse and rider combination

Section 5.04 Apple Knoll is offering ring time to complete tests should the rider choose to do so

- (a) It is the rider's responsibility to pay and to contact Apple Knoll to arrange a time slot
- (b) Contact Carol Mayo at jpcamayo@comcast.net or Carol Burkhardt at cburkhart3636@gmail.com to arrange a day and time

Article VI. Submitting Entry Forms, Videos, and Payment

Section 6.01 Entry forms and payment will be submitted through a Google Form

- (a) Entry fee is \$25 for CRDA members and \$30 for non-members
- (b) Entries and/or payment submitted after the closing date will incur a \$10 late fee per test
- (c) Videos submitted after the closing date will also incur a \$10 late fee per test

- (d) Payment options are PayPal or check and all the details on how to submit payment are on the entry form
